CO Prevention

- Yes ___ No ___ Have you installed at least one battery-powered CO alarm or AC-powered unit with battery backup on each level of your home and near sleeping areas?
- Yes ___ No ___ Has a licensed professional inspected the heating systems and other fuel-burning appliances in your home annually?
- Yes ___ No ___ Have you made sure that fuel-burning appliances are installed properly and operate according to the manufacturer's instructions?
- Yes ___ No ___ Do you have all fireplaces cleaned and inspected annually and keep chimneys clear of animal nests, leaves and residue to ensure proper venting?
- Yes ___ No ___ Have you made sure not to block or seal shut the exhaust flues or ducts used by water heaters, ranges and clothes dryers?
- Yes ___ No ___ Are you careful not to leave your car running in an attached garage or carport?
- Yes ___ No ___ Are you careful not to use ovens or stoves to heat your home?
- Yes ___ No ___ Do not use charcoal or gas grills inside or operate outdoors near a window where CO fumes could seep in through a window.
- Yes ___ No ___ Do you check all carbon monoxide alarms in your home? Do they use the most accurate sensing technology? Do they need new batteries?
- Yes ___ No ___ Do you replace CO alarms every five years in order to benefit from the latest technology upgrades?
